This guide will help you get started with setting up web hosting and email services.

## First Decision: DNS Management

Before setting up your web hosting and email services, you'll need to decide how you want to manage your DNS (Domain Name System) records. You have two options:

### 1) Use Get.vi DNS (Recommended for Most Users)

- We'll manage your DNS records for you
- Easy setup of web hosting and email services
- No technical DNS knowledge required
- Free with your domain purchase

### 2) Use Your Own DNS Servers

- Ideal if you're using specialized hosting services
- We'll point your domain to your DNS servers
- You'll manage all DNS records yourself
- Contact us with your DNS server addresses to set this up

You have several options for email hosting:

## Popular Email Hosting Services

- ◆ **Google Workspace**
  - ◆ Professional email (@yourdomain.vi)
  - ◆ Includes Google Docs, Drive, and Meet
  - ◆ 30GB-unlimited storage
  - ◆ Starting at \$6/user/month
- ◆ **Microsoft 365**
  - ◆ Business email with Outlook
  - ◆ Includes Office apps
  - ◆ 50GB email storage
  - ◆ From \$5/user/month
- ◆ **Zoho**
  - ◆ Affordable business email
  - ◆ Clean interface
  - ◆ 5GB-50GB storage
  - ◆ Starting at \$1/user/month

## Common DNS Records You May Need

When setting up services, you may need to configure these common DNS records:

- ◆ A Record: Points your domain to your web host's IP address
- ◆ MX Records: Direct email to your email service provider
- ◆ CNAME Records: Create aliases for your domain
- ◆ TXT Records: Verify domain ownership and email security

If you are using our DNS services, you will need to provide the above. Your web hosting provider and email provider will typically provide this information.
